KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

The Conference Committee are delighted to announce the keynote speakers for the conference are Alexander (Sandy) Heriot (St Vincent's Hospital, Melbourne), Mr Andrew Smith and Mr Simon Dexter (St James University Hospital, Leeds).



Alexander (Sandy) Heriot Ma MB BChir Md FRCS (gen.) FRCSed FRACS

Sandy Heriot is a consultant colorectal surgeon at the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre, St Vincent's Hospital, and Senior Fellow at The University of Melbourne.

His colorectal surgery training has been extensive, including St Marks Hospital, London, the Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio, and St Vincent's Hospital in Melbourne.

He is a member of the Colorectal Surgical Society of Australia and New Zealand, and committee member for the International Society of Laparoscopic Colorectal Surgery as well as a reviewer for a number of colorectal journals. He has written widely on the management of rectal cancer and IBD.



Mr Andrew Smith MB BS BSc DM FRCS (Gen)

Mr Andrew Smith is a consultant HPB surgeon at St James University Hospital in Leeds, and he is the surgical lead for pancreatic disease within the Yorkshire Cancer Network and performs over 80 major pancreas resections per year.

He has an active research programme in benign and malignant pancreatic disease and medical education. His HPB training was undertaken in Leicester and Nottingham, including an HPB and laparoscopic fellowship at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, USA.



Mr Simon Dexter BM DM FRCS (Gen) FCSHK

Consultant in Upper Gastro-Intestinal and Minimally Invasive Surgery at St James' University Hospital in Leeds. He is a past chairman of the Yorkshire Cancer Network, Upper GI section.

Mr Dexter has been involved in laparoscopic surgery since its inception in the UK in 1990 and was the UK's first laparoscopic surgery research fellow. His advanced surgical training took him through Leeds General Infirmary, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, Tufts Medical Centre, Boston, USA, and the National Cancer Centre Hospital, Tokyo.

He is currently executive treasurer of the British Obesity and Metabolic Surgery Society and a council member of the Association of Upper GI Surgeons of GB and Ireland. As well as being on the

permanent teaching faculty of LIMIT (Leeds Institute for Minimally Invasive Therapy), he is on the teaching faculty for several courses at the Royal College of Surgeons of England.

Mr Dexter specialises in laparoscopic and oesophago-gastric surgery, and he has a particular interest in laparoscopic obesity surgery, both primary and revisional.




